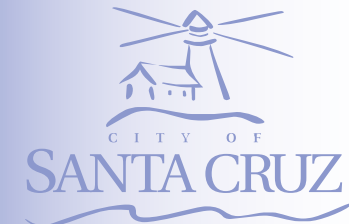

Environmentally Acceptable Packaging and Products Ordinance



Reducing the Impact of Single Use Disposables

Reusable is Best

- Reusable dishware that is washed and reused saves money and reduces litter.



Fiber Based is Great

- Must be BPI or other third party certified PFAS free.
- Traditional and Bio-Plastic Not Allowed.



Accessories Upon Request

- Includes: knives, spoons, forks, chopsticks, condiment cups and packets, straws, stirrers, splash sticks drink plugs.



25¢ Fee On Cups

- Fee added to each disposable cup sold containing a beverage.
- Fee must appear on receipt.

Clearly label containers for easy navigation of disposal requirements

RECYCLING-Note: NO CUPS!!

- Empty plastic and glass bottles, jugs, jars and tubs.
- Aluminum and tin cans
- Empty and broken down cardboard boxes
- clean paper

FOOD WASTE- Note: NO PACKAGING

- Food only



TRASH- All Cups, soiled napkins, food packaging, and anything not listed above.



The Single-Use Bag Reduction Ordinance stipulates:

- Plastic carryout bags may not be provided by special event promoters or vendors.

Protect the Monterey Bay National Marine Sanctuary! It's home to 33 species of mammals, 94 species of seabirds, 345 species of fish, and contains the largest kelp forest in the nation!

These ordinances are mandatory. Fines will be levied for non-compliance.
