

ORDINANCE NO. 2024-14

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SANTA CRUZ AMENDING CHAPTER 2.40, BOARDS AND COMMISSIONS, SECTION 2.40.110, ESTABLISHMENT OF COMMISSION FOR PREVENTION OF VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN, OF THE SANTA CRUZ MUNICIPAL CODE

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Santa Cruz as follows:

Section 1. Chapter 2.40 – Boards and Commissions is hereby amended at Section 2.40.110 – Establishment of Commission for Prevention of Violence Against Women to read as follows:

“2.40.110 ESTABLISHMENT OF COMMISSION FOR PREVENTION OF VIOLENCE AGAINST WOMEN.

Pursuant to Initiative Ordinance No. 81-29, there is hereby established a commission of the city of Santa Cruz to be known as the commission for the prevention of violence against women. Each commissioner shall serve a four-year term of office beginning February 1st. If the nominating councilmember leaves office prior to the expiration of the councilmember’s term, the commissioner’s term shall expire with the councilmember’s term and the succeeding councilmember shall nominate a new commissioner to fill the unexpired term.”
