SANTA CRUZ, CA – The Santa Cruz Police Department is investigating the death of a male found near the Palomar Inn off Pacific Avenue at 2:40 p.m. on Saturday, October 5, 2024. The investigation is ongoing regarding the details leading up to the male's cause of death. Detectives are following up on all possible avenues to determine if there is any evidence of foul play.

The identity of the male and his cause of death are pending verification by the Santa Cruz County Coroner.
