R. Solick discussed the potential impacts on City employees and productivity. A Human Resources policy was discussed. No action was taken.

V. Emergency Preparedness Forum, Scheduled for October 2009

Chair/Councilmember Robinson announced details of the Emergency Preparedness Forum scheduled for October  $15^{th}$  as part of the  $20^{th}$  Anniversary remembrance of the Loma Prieta Earthquake. No action was taken.
