

Driving by Sign Designations



Map-type signs first identify a Roundabout intersection ahead. **Slow down.** Signs identify upcoming cross streets and inform you which lane to travel in when the Roundabout has multiple lanes. **Get in your lane. Share the road with cyclists.**



All vehicles must yield to pedestrians at Roundabouts. **Prepare to yield or STOP.**



Vehicles must yield to traffic in the Roundabout. **Prepare to slow down or STOP.**



All vehicles must turn **right** and circulate in a counter-clockwise direction. **Keep right of island.**



Street signs will indicate your exit destination.

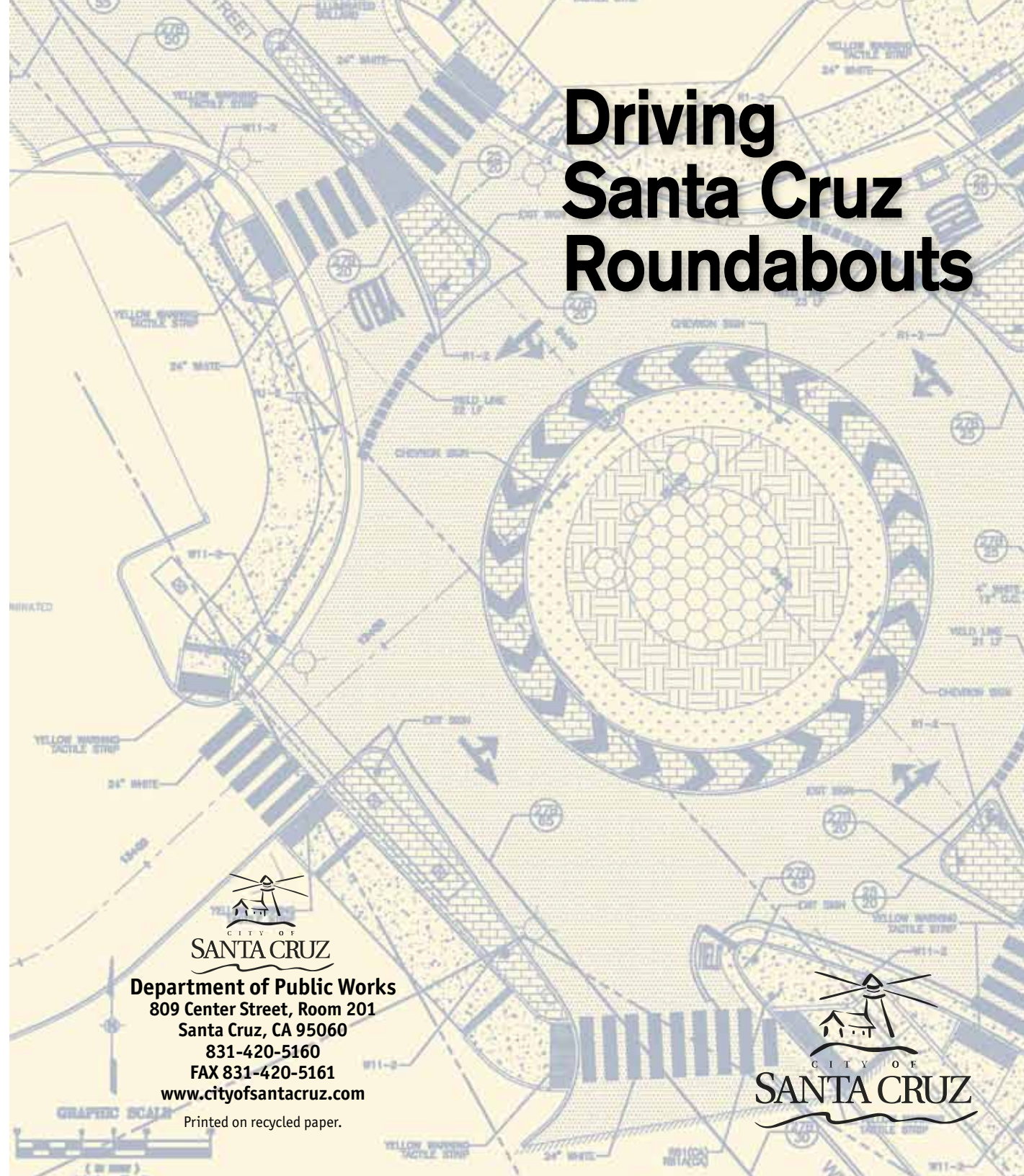


Hear sirens? If you have not yet entered the Roundabout, pull over to the right. If you are inside the Roundabout continue to your exit and then pull over to the right.



Watch for flashing lights at railroad crossings. **Prepare to STOP.**

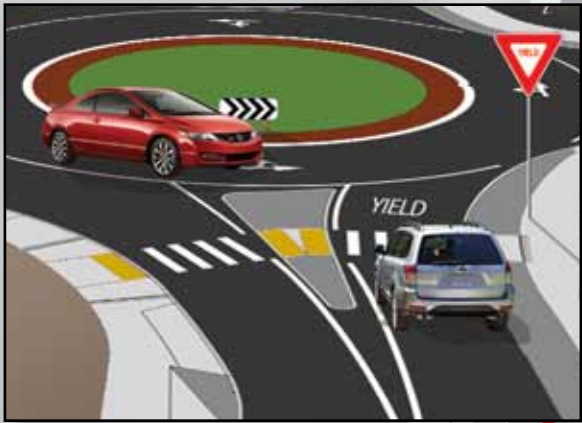
