SANTA CRUZ POLICE DEPARTMENT ANNOUNCES ROAD CLOSURES AND DETOURS FOR JULY 4TH

In order to maintain a safe environment, the Santa Cruz Police Department will be deploying additional law enforcement resources throughout the City on July 4th. Due to the anticipated volume of traffic, vehicular access to the Seabright neighborhood will be restricted to residents, patrons of Chardonnay Sailing Charters and Aldo's restaurant from approximately 7 p.m. to Midnight on July 4th. There will be unrestricted pedestrian and bicycle access to the area.

The Santa Cruz Police Department will be engaging in pro-active enforcement of all laws, including public intoxication, public consumption of alcoholic beverages, disturbance violations, possession of illegal fireworks and driving under the influence of alcohol.

DETOURS

Southbound Ocean Street will be detoured onto westbound San Lorenzo Blvd
Eastbound San Lorenzo Blvd will be detoured to northbound Ocean Street
Southbound Buena Vista Avenue will be detoured to westbound East Cliff Drive
Southbound Seabright Avenue will be detoured to westbound Murray Street
Westbound Hiawatha will be detoured to westbound East Cliff Drive

CLOSURES

- The Murray Street Bridge will be closed between Seabright Avenue and 7th Avenue, access to the Harbor from Santa Cruz City will be off 7th Avenue via Capitola Road.
- All roads south of East Cliff Drive between Buena Vista Ave and the Yacht Harbor will be closed (residents, Aldo's restaurant patrons and Chardonnay passengers only).
- Eastbound East Cliff Drive at Ocean Street will be closed

GAINING ACCESS

- Residents requesting entrance to the East Cliff Point area will need to show proof of residency at East Cliff Drive and Ocean Street to gain access.
- Residents requesting entrance south of Murray Street will need to show proof of residency at Seabright Avenue and Murray Street to gain access.
- Chardonnay passengers will have to show a voucher, provided by Chardonnay Sailing Charters, with the correct date and time to gain access.
