INFORMATION:

On December 14th, the Santa Cruz Police Department reported on a child annoying/attempted child lure case that occurred on December 13th. In that case, a 15 year-old girl was riding her bike to school when an unknown male (sketch attached) pulled alongside her in his car and asked her to help him find his missing cat. He said he would pay her to help him find his cat. She ignored him and continued to ride her bike to school. When she reached the Seabright and Broadway area the same individual pulled alongside her again in his vehicle and made a similar request. She ignored him and rode to school. It appears as though the suspect followed her during this time. The victim reported the incident to school officials and our School Resource Officer worked with her to obtain suspect information (description above).

Yesterday, the same victim stated she saw the same individual in the area of Buena Vista/Idaho/Cayuga and he attempted to make contact with her again. The victim stated she again ignored him and rode to school. The victim was not injured and never spoke to the suspect. The department is working with school officials and has provided them with the sketch. Investigators are looking to see if other jurisdictions have had similar cases or if any other cases in our area could be related. At this point, no additional cases have been linked to this suspect.

The vehicle is described as a white, four-door sedan (unknown make/model/year) without a rear license plate. No additional vehicle information is available. Late yesterday the victim came in to provide a sketch to investigators. The department has increased patrols in the area of the incidents. *Note that yesterday we believed the first incident occurred on the Riverside Bridge – we now believe that these incidents have been concentrated in the Buena Vista, Cayuga, Idaho, Seabright, Broadway area.*
