

## SANTA CRUZ COUNTY LAW ENFORCEMENT MEDIA ADVISORY

The Santa Cruz Police Department, California Highway Patrol and Santa Cruz County Sheriff's Office are alerting residents to possible traffic delays on March 1<sup>st</sup> in conjunction with a scheduled protest at UCSC. We expect the greatest traffic impacts to be in areas near the campus and the surrounding feeder streets. Residents are advised to allot extra time when travelling through the area. In addition, local law enforcement will work to ensure emergency vehicle access is maintained to city and county areas near the university. If excessive delays occur, local law enforcement will provide information through the media, Nixle alert system and other public notification means.
