1. Intertie Analysis Status Report

Assistant Engineer S. O'Hara introduced this item and Tony Akel, Akel Engineering. Mr. Akel presented the Intertie Analysis Report. A copy of the PowerPoint presentation will be included in the original papers.

Mayor D. Lane moved approval of the staff recommendation to approve the proposed work schedule for the completion of the Intertie Analysis Report:

- Determine maximum amount of desal that can be delivered at all times with construction of segment 1 and 2
- Complete cost and water quality analysis including segment 3 (for complete documentation of analysis)
- The Task Force concurred with the Soquel Creek Water District Board recommendation to construct segment one and two of the preferred alignment even though it will not be able to provide 2.5 mgd to the District during summer months.
