The Clothesline Project

The Clothesline Project breaks the silence about domestic violence by giving a voice to survivors, victims, and community members. The clothesline was chosen to honor women's traditional information exchange over the backyard fences while hanging laundry out to dry. The clothesline displays T-shirts designed by survivors of various types of abuse, those who have lost loved ones to it, and allies in our community. The designed shirts are displayed during the Day of Unity event on clotheslines displayed at various locations along Pacific Avenue.
