2. Environmental Review Support Services – Contract Amendment No. 2

Mayor Lane moved to recommend approval of Contract Amendment No. 2 with Strelow Consulting for environmental support services during development and completion of environmental review of the **scwd**² Desalination Project.

Jaffe moved to recommend approval of the scope of work and budget with Kennedy / Jenks Consultants for Independent Technical Advisory Services for the **scwd**² Desalination Program; that the Task Force receive a presentation on the education and communication component as part of the kick-off of the work program; and that based on the discussion the task force be provided informational materials for review and approval. Program Managers' Report
