TOPIC: Surf School Molest Case - Additional Location **CASE NUMBER:** 13S-06388

INFORMATION:

Another location has been identified in the investigation of Santa Cruz Surf School owner and operator Dylan Greiner. Investigators have identified a new location where Mr. Greiner was secretly taking inappropriate photos of young girls. The latest revelation involved the Seahorse Swim School operating out of the swimming pool at the Santa Cruz High School Campus. Seahorse Swim School was renting the pool facility for swim classes. Other than renting the facility, Santa Cruz City Schools did not have an affiliation with the swim school and are not responsible for the employees or volunteers of the swim school.

The ownership of the Seahorse Swim School is completely cooperative with the police department's investigation. Mr. Greiner's association with the swim school was as a volunteer. His surf school was brought in as a special guest for "Pool Jr. Guard" programs run by the swim school.

In all of the locations, Detectives have identified over a dozen victims in this case. Additionally, we have received over 100 inquiries from concerned parents. Detectives are identifying victims and locations as quickly as possible.
