1. 1108 Pacific Ave. CP13-0138 APN 005-153-31  
Administrative Use Permit to serve beer and wine (Type 41 license) at a new restaurant ("Assembly") located in the CBD zone district (Environmental Determination: Categorical Exemption) (Centro Partners, owner/filed: 9/19/2013) JL  
Recommendation: That the Zoning Administrator acknowledge the environmental determination and approve the Administrative Use Permit, subject to the findings noted in the staff report and the Conditions of Approval, listed in Exhibit "A".
