Coastal and Design Permits to add four hotel rooms to result in a 48-room hotel (Beach Street Inn) located in the RT(C)/CZO/SPO zone district. (Environmental Determination: Categorical Exemption). (Beach Street Inn, LLC, owner/filed: 5/29/2014)

Recommendation: That the Zoning Administrator acknowledge the environmental determination and approve the Coastal and Design permits, with findings noted in the staff report and Conditions of Approval, listed as Exhibit "A".

This project requires a Coastal Permit which is appealable to the California Coastal Commission after all possible appeals are exhausted through the City.
