1. 244 San Lorenzo Blvd. CP14-0154 APN 007-422-12

Tentative Map, Coastal Permit, Design Permit, and Demolition Authorization Permit to demolish an existing single-family residence and to construct four townhouse units in the RM Zone District. Requires a Variance to reduce the minimum lot width from 65 feet to 50 feet. (Environmental Determination: Categorical Exemption) (Lemmon Dorothy Adele, owner/filed: 11/18/2014)SH This project requires a Coastal Permit which is appealable to the California Coastal Commission after all possible appeals are exhausted through the City.

<u>Recommendation</u>: That the Zoning Administrator acknowledge the Environmental Determination and approve the Tentative Map, Coastal Permit, Design Permit, Variance, and Demolition Authorization Permit, per the findings noted in the staff report and the Conditions of Approval, listed as Exhibit "A".
