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**INFORMATION:**

On October 17, 2015 at about 2024 hours, Santa Cruz Police Department and Santa Cruz Fire Department were dispatched to the area of the Santa Cruz Municipal Wharf to investigate a possible vehicle that crashed through the guard rail at the Wharf and fell into water. Officers responded to the scene and confirmed the report. Several witnesses saw the incident and reported it to the police. Santa Cruz Fire Department Rescue Divers responded to the area and assisted in pulling a male adult subject from the car. Wharf Maintenance Divers also responded to assist. Wharf Maintenance Divers assisted in pulling a second male subject from the vehicle. One male subject was later pronounced deceased at Dominican Hospital. The second subject remains in critical condition. The vehicle was later pulled from the water and recovered from a depth of approximately 25 feet. The incident is under investigation.
