1. Adjacent to 665 Chestnut Street CP16-0069 APN: NA Administrative Use Permit, Special Use Permit and Design Permit for a telecommunication facility in the public right-of-way adjacent to 665 Chestnut Street. (Environmental Determination: Categorical Exemption) (Jason Osborn for Crown Castle, filed 4/6/16) MF RECOMMENDATION: That the Planning Commission acknowledge the environmental determination and approve the Administrative Use Permit, the Special Use Permit and the Design Permit based on the Findings in the staff report and the Conditions of Approval.

ACTION: The Planning Commission ACKNOWLEDGED the environmental determination and APPROVED the Administrative Use Permit, the Special Use Permit and the Design Permit on a vote of 4-0-1-2 with Commissioners Conway, Mesiti-Miller, Pepping and Nielsen in favor, none opposed, Chair Spellman recused, and Commissioners Blizinski and Kennedy absent.

2. 338 Frederick Street CP16-0040 APN 011-092-62

APPEAL of Zoning Administrator's approval of Design Permit to legalize the conversion of an attached garage and enclosed deck to habitable space, and construct a two-story addition to an existing two-story single-family residence, a detached carport and a detached shed on a substandard lot in the R-1-5 zone district. (Coastal Permit Exclusion) (Environmental Determination: Categorical Exemption) (COLIN AND MARYANNE CAMPBELL owner/filed: 2/25/2016) NC

RECOMMENDATION: That the Planning Commission acknowledge the environmental determination and deny the appeal, thereby upholding the Zoning Administrator's approval of the Design Permit.

ACTION: The Planning Commission <u>ACKNOWLEDGED</u> the environmental determination and <u>DENIED</u> the appeal, thereby upholding the Zoning Administrator's approval of the Design Permit on a vote of 5-0-2 with

Commissioners Conway, Nielsen, Mesiti-Miller, Pepping and Spellman in favor, none opposed and Commissioners Kennedy and Blizinski absent.

3. Two Ordinances Amending Zoning Ordinance Chapters 24.12, and 24.22 of the City of Santa Cruz Municipal Code and the City's Local Coastal Program. RECOMMENDATION: That the Planning Commission recommend that the City Council approve two Ordinances updating Chapter 24.12 related to electric vehicle charging infrastructure and bicycle parking requirements of the City of Santa Cruz Municipal Code and the City's Local Coastal Program and Section 24.22 of the City of Santa Cruz Municipal Code updating associated definitions.

<u>APPEALS</u> - Any person who believes that a final action of this advisory body has been taken in error may appeal that decision to the City Council. Appeals must be in writing, setting forth the nature of the action and the basis upon which the action is considered to be in error, and addressed to the City Council in care of the <u>City Clerk</u>.

Appeals must be received by the City Clerk within ten (10) calendar days following the date of the action from which such appeal is being taken. An appeal must be accompanied by a five hundred fourteen dollar (\$514) filing fee, unless the item involves a Coastal Permit that is appealable to the Coastal Commission, in which case there is no fee.
