Coastal Permit, Slope Modification, and Design Permit for an addition and remodel of two units resulting in a single-family residence with an attached basement/garage requiring a Variance to reduce front yard and side yard setback requirements on a property located in the R-1-5/CZ-O/SP-O zone district. (Environmental Determination: Categorical Exemption) (JENSEN ERIC CHARLES, owner/filed: 2/7/2017) RB

This project requires a Coastal Permit which is appealable to the California Coastal Commission after all possible appeals are exhausted through the City
