## **INFORMATION:**

On Monday August 20, 2018 at approximately 1842, Santa Cruz Police Officers responded to the area of 2<sup>nd</sup> and Main St for a report of a possible fight involving a male and a female. Multiple people called to report the incident, one person reported the male party had a female by the throat and was pulling her into the vehicle. Another person reported the driver was assaulting the female in the car.

The vehicle was located on Ocean St near Water St. An officer attempted to stop the car, the driver refused to pull over and fled from the officer. The driver drove on to Market St. The driver accelerated to a speed eventually pulling away from the Santa Cruz Police Officer. The officer lost site of the car momentarily, and found the car had driven off the road in the area of Market St and Stoney Creek.

All he occupants had left the vehicle and fled from the scene, into the surrounding neighborhood and creek. With the assistance of the Santa Cruz Sheriff's Office, the 4 occupants were located. All four occupants were not cooperative surrounding the initial call, why they fled from the officers, and denied a domestic disturbance occurred. All occupants were arrested for the listed charges. One of the occupants was injured in the crash and was treated at the hospital.
