TO THE HONORABLE Chris Krohn,

Pursuant to Section 11020, California Elections Code, the undersigned, registered, qualified voters of The City of Santa Cruz, in the State of California, hereby give notice that we are the proponents of a recall petition and that we intend to seek your recall and removal from the office of City Council, in Santa Cruz, California, and to demand election of a successor in that office.

The grounds for the recall are as follows:

Councilmember Krohn repeatedly voted against closing the Ross Camp, while failing to pursue legal, realistic, and humane solutions to homelessness in the City of Santa Cruz. By opposing the closure of the Ross Camp, he contradicted the recommendations of Fire Chief Hajduk and County Health Officer Leff, and endangered the health and safety of Santa Cruz residents, both housed and unhoused.

Councilmember Krohn attempted to establish permanent RV parking sites and permanent homeless encampments in residential neighborhoods and city parks in Santa Cruz, without regard for public safety or potential damage to local businesses, and without consulting neighborhood residents, the Fire Department, or the Police Department.

Councilmember Krohn betrayed public trust and violated the Brown Act by requesting closed city council sessions to discuss relocation of the Ross Camp. He has failed to work productively with council peers and City staff, and has neglected his duty as a Councilmember by walking out of two City Council sessions. He has failed to abide by the Rules of Procedure for Conduct of City Council Business by refusing to treat his fellow Councilmembers with respect, and has demonstrated that he is unfit to serve as a Councilmember of the City of Santa Cruz.

NOTICE OF INTENTION TO CIRCULATE RECALL PETITION

The original Notice of Intention and the proof of service will be filed with the City Elections Official.

Elections Code section 11023. (a) Within seven days after the filing of the notice of intention, the officer sought to be recalled may file with the elections official, or in the case of a state officer, the Secretary of State, an answer, in not more than 200 words, to the statement of the proponents; (b) If an answer is filed, the officer shall, within seven days after the filing of the notice of intention, also serve a copy of it, by personal delivery or by certified mail, on one of the proponents named in the notice of intention; (c) The answer shall be signed and shall be accompanied by the printed name and business or residence address of the officer sought to be recalled.
