**INFORMATION:**

On Wednesday June 3, 2020 at approximately 7pm. The Santa Cruz Police Department responded to a victim of a shooting in the 400 block of Cedar St. When the initial officer arrived on scene he found the victim on the ground suffering from a gunshot wound to their leg. The victim was losing a large amount of blood. The initial officer performed lifesaving measures and applied a tourniquet. The victim was transported to a trauma hospital in San Jose.

Currently Detectives are following up with the victim and witnesses. Detectives have collected evidence from the scene. At this time all motives for the crime are being investigated. The victim is currently recovering at the hospital.

While the incident occurred during the time of the Black Lives Matter march, the two incidents are separate and not related in anyway.
