- ☐ 5,000 SOLAR HOMES (3,567)
- ☐ 500 SOLAR BUSINESSES (116)
- ☐ MEET 30% OF MUNI ENERGY LOAD W/RE (~23%) + REDUCE LOAD BY 40%
- ☐ 75% WASTE DIVERSION (60.3%)
- ☐ REDUCE SOV COMMUTES 10% (3.1%)
- ☐ 20% CARS ARE LOW CARBON (11%)
- ☐ 100% FUNDING FOR RAIL/TRAIL (89%)
- ☐ URBAN TREE CANOPY +10% (2%)
- ☐ EXPAND ENERGY EFFICIENCY TO 30% OF HOMES (7.5%)

Reduce community-wide greenhouse gas emissions 30% by 2020 and 80% by 2050 (compared to 1990 levels).

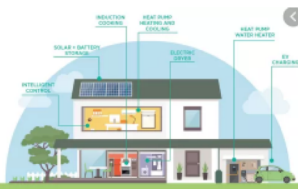
