Santa Cruz Police Arrest Three Gang-Affiliated Suspects in Connection with a Shooting Investigation

SANTA CRUZ, CA - On August 29th, 2021, at about 10:55 pm, Santa Cruz Police responded to a shooting in the 100 block of Blaine Street. Officers found the intended victim, who was NOT struck by the single gunshot fired into an apartment building. Fortunately, no one was injured by the bullet. Several witnesses provided accurate descriptions of the suspects. Officers searched the area, and in quick order, found the three suspects getting into a getaway car a block away from the shooting.

The suspects were detained without incident and arrested. All three suspects are affiliated with a local street gang. One of the suspects, Jose Lopez, was discovered in possession of a .22 caliber handgun found in his backpack. The patrol-led investigation revealed that the shooting was gang-motivated.

The suspects arrested are named below with charges.

Jose Lopez Age 28: Resident of Watsonville
