



ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING AND PARKING IN SANTA CRUZ



The City of Santa Cruz supports the use of zero/low emission vehicles as part of its efforts to reduce greenhouse gases and improve Santa Cruz air quality.

As of March 2022, thanks to grant funding, we have installed 12 spaces with Blink electric vehicle charging stations for public use located at the addresses below.

The Blink chargers are compatible with all plug-in hybrid and fully electric vehicles. They work with or without an app. Without the app, a touch credit card is needed. To download the Blink app, visit <https://blinkcharging.com/corporate/blink-mobile-app/>.

The Blink chargers have touch screens that tell the user the rates.

Due to the limited number of chargers, the EV parking spots are for electric vehicles only. If your vehicle is not charging, you may be ticketed or towed.
