2/10/21	Warrant Service  WPD Assistance	21W-00534	WPD advised that they were attempting to apprehend a potentially armed suspect in relation to narcotics trafficking and violent sexual assault. This investigation was a multi-agency, multi-jurisdictional case including Santa Cruz County Sheriff's, Watsonville Police Department, Santa Clara County Sheriff's Department as well as the FBI. The SCPD Bearcat was used to facilitate the safe arrival of the Watsonville Police SRU (Special Response Unit). The Bearcat was positioned outside of the residence, where the loud speaker was used to have the occupants of the residence exit. Ultimately the suspect fled out of the rear of the residence and was taken into custody without incident.

3/30/21	Armed Barricade	21S-01850	Santa Cruz Police Department responded to a report of a battery involving a male subject reportedly in possession of a firearm.  The suspect made statements about killing others and killing himself. The ARV was utilized to provide SCPD personnel with a position of coverage while working to secure the scene. During this time, SCPD personnel were able to coordinate ensuring the safety of nearby civilians and residential structures and the suspect was taken into custody.
4/1/21	Warrant Service  WPD Assistance	21S-01047	The ARV was used to transport the Watsonville PD's SRT members to serve a high risk search/arrest warrant. The suspect in this case was wanted for an attempted murder and the firearm used in the commission of the crime was still outstanding. The ARV as utilized to safely perform the search warrant service at the residence.
4/15/21	Maintenance Drive	N/A	During the ARV's last service at the Santa Cruz Ford dealership, it was advised that the Bearcat needed to be driven weekly. It was explained that the turbo and engine should be warmed up and exercised on a weekly basis to ensure it maintains proper working order. The vehicle was driven to satisfy the recommendation from dealership.

4/20/21	SCSO Assistance	21S-03263	SCSO Deputies in Boulder Creek witnessed an individual with a rifle enter a pop-out trailer. The individual was a convicted felon and prohibited from possessing firearms. The SCSO attempted to contact the subject, who was unresponsive to Deputies. Deputies obtained a search and arrest warrant for the suspect and requested the assistance of the ARV rescue vehicle to safely execute the arrest. SCPD Officers responded code three with lights and sirens.  The SCPD Bearcat was used to facilitate the safe arrival of the Santa Cruz County Sheriff's Office Tactical team to the above listed address. The Bearcat was positioned in front of the pop-out trailer offering Cover for the tactical team. The loud speaker was used to

			hail out the suspect by Officers until a negotiator arrived on scene taking over. During attempted negotiations the suspect exited the trailer and less lethal munitions were used. It appeared the suspect had a concealed firework which was detonated simultaneously by the suspect. Deputies were able to take the suspect into custody.

The Bearcat was utilized to give the SCSO a safe working area close to the motorhome, as a precautionary measure in the event that chemical agents started a fire. Upon entry and search, the motorhome was determined to be unoccupied.
<b>9/13/21</b>	Warrant Service  US Marshalls Assistance	21S-05575	The US Marshalls notified dispatch that they would be conducting surveillance in Santa Cruz with the intent of apprehending a wanted fugitive. The suspect fled from the Marshalls, barricading himself inside his location. SCPD assisted in setting up a perimeter around the residence, and the Bearcat was deployed on scene at the front of the residence. The Bearcat provided protection for personnel, its PA was utilized for verbal commands and its lights assisted in illuminating the scene. The suspect was eventually taken into custody without incident.
<b>10/3/21</b>	Warrant Service	21S-06007	High-risk warrant service with assault rifles and drugs in large fortified residence. The suspects were arrested in possession of AR-15 rifles and significant amounts of cocaine.

<b>11/2/21</b>	Warrant Service  WPD Assistance	21W-04240	Assisted with the service of a high-risk search and arrest warrant in Watsonville. The warrant was related to a double-homicide that occurred in October, 2021 in Monterey County. The Bearcat was driven to the front of the residence to provide cover for the WPD Special Response Unit. All occupants were cooperative and the subject in the warrant was taken into custody without incident.
