RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SANTA CRUZ
ADOPTING A SCHEDULE OF FEES FOR DISPOSAL OF REFUSE, GARBAGE AND
TRASH AND PROCESSING RECYCLABLES AT THE RESOURCE RECOVERY FACILITY
AND RESCINDING RESOLUTION NO. NS-27,779

WHEREAS, the City of Santa Cruz maintains a Resource Recovery Facility for the disposal of refuse, garbage and trash and processing recyclables; and

WHEREAS, this Council does find and determine that the users of the Resource Recovery Facility should bear their fair share of the City's cost in operating the Resource Recovery Facility; and

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution No. NS-27,779 on February 12, 2008, revising the schedule of fees for disposal of refuse, garbage, trash and processing recyclables at the Resource Recovery Facility; and

WHEREAS, the costs of operating the Resource Recovery Facility have increased since fees were last adopted.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of Santa Cruz that Resolution No. NS-27,779 is hereby rescinded.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the schedule of fees contained herein for disposal of refuse, garbage and trash and processing recyclables at the Resource Recovery Facility are hereby adopted. This resolution shall take effect February 1, 2015 and commencing on February 1, 2015 every person using the City's Resource Recovery Facility shall pay the fees and charges herein, including the increases shown herein as taking effect on July 1, 2016, July 1, 2017, and July 1, 2018.

4. All uncovered loads will be assessed a surcharge as show in the fee schedule.
5. All trailers with beds over eight (8) feet in length are required to weigh on the scale and be charged based on tonnage.
6. No discounts are given for airspace contained within load.
7. North Coast County Residents surcharge: Stated Rates + 28%
8. The Director of Public Works is authorized to reduce or waive fees for certain materials for a specified time period if those materials are deemed necessary for construction or operational uses at the Resource Recovery Facility.
