I have read and agree to comply with the Oversized Vehicle Overnight Parking Permit Guidelines. I understand that an Oversized Vehicle Overnight Parking Permit does not waive compliance with any other applicable parking law, regulation or ordinance. I have read and understand the following Municipal Code provisions related to this permit:

- “A resident oversized vehicle permit allows a resident to park an oversized vehicle for four periods of up to seventy-two consecutive hours per calendar month. The oversized vehicle must be absent from the location . . . for a minimum of twenty-four consecutive hours to be lawfully parked overnight at the location again.” (SCMC 10.40.120(i).)
- “Every person who displays a fraudulent, forged, altered or counterfeit oversized vehicle parking permit or permit number is guilty of an infraction for the first offense. Any subsequent offense committed within twelve months of a previous citation is a misdemeanor.” (SCMC 10.40.120(k).)
- The permitted oversized vehicle must park “at the street curb immediately adjacent to the address for which the oversized vehicle parking permit has been granted, or within four hundred feet”. (SCMC 10.40.120(h)(2)).
- This permit may be revoked if it is determined that the oversized vehicle will “create a traffic hazard or otherwise . . . adversely affect public safety, traffic flow, bike lanes, or access.” (SCMC 10.40.120(h)(5).)
