



## PARKING SERVICES



Electric Vehicle Charging Stations are located at various parking lots and garages throughout the City (see map). Please note signage and fee for charging at each location.



Throughout the Downtown Corridor there are numerous Bike Locker locations in parking garages and lots. For a small hourly fee, your bicycle will be safe and secure as you work, shop, commute or just enjoy Downtown Santa Cruz.

## ON-STREET

### Metered Parking

Meters operate 8am–8pm every day. Downtown metered parking is free on City holidays. All details and rates are posted on parking meters.

### Parkmobile

Mobile payment is available via the Parkmobile app at all parking meters and paid-parking lots. For more information and to set up an account download the app or visit [parkmobile.com](http://parkmobile.com).

### Accessible Parking with Placard

Parking with a designated placard or license plate is free at on-street meters.

### Loading Zones

Passenger Loading (white zones): maximum 3 minutes enforced 24/7.

Commercial Loading (yellow zones): provide free parking for commercially plated vehicles 7am–6pm maximum 20 minutes.

Dual Use Commercial Loading/Metered: commercial loading/unloading 7am–1pm; metered parking 1pm–8pm Mon–Sat and 8am–8pm Sun.

## OFF-STREET

### Free Short Term Parking

Available in designated downtown public parking lots. Three-hour time limits are enforced Mon–Sat, 8am–6pm and are not enforced on Sundays and City holidays (see map).

### Paid Parking

To park longer than 2–3 hours, park at one of our pay-by-space lots or an attended parking facility (see map).

### Accessible Parking

Van-Accessible spaces are clearly signed and marked along Pacific Avenue and in the off-street lots and garages. Parking fees apply to all pay-by-space and attended facilities. Placards/plates do not exempt you from parking in restricted white, yellow or red zones.

### Permit Parking

Employees and residents of the Downtown Parking District may purchase permits for use in downtown garages and lots based on availability. ## PROGRAMS

### Santa Cruz ParkCard

ParkCards work in parking meters and pay stations. ParkCards are accepted at all Santa Cruz parking meters except on Pacific Avenue between Laurel and Water streets where credit cards are accepted.

### Wharf Local's Pass

Enjoy 2 hours of free parking per day throughout the year (some restrictions apply) when you purchase a Local's Parking Pass. Available at Wharf gate booths and downtown garages. Pass cost: City residents \$20; County residents \$25.

### GO Santa Cruz
